



Fox Lea Farm

As a 40 year resident and business owner in Venice, I have experienced 1st hand the positive impact Fox Lea Farm has had on our area. Besides hosting equestrian events year round, the facility preserves green space close to town and offers stabling, lessons and activities for local resident horse enthusiasts.

My first exposure to Fox Lea was back on the late 1980's when Fox Lea brought a world class Dressage Event to Venice. As I was very involved with the Tourism Committee at the Venice Chamber, I saw the impact such an event had on our economy. Since then, in both my positions as owner of Bogey's (until 2008) and as owner of Crow's Nest, I have always been aware when the 'horse people' are in town. The demographic of the typical Fox Lea attendee is one of affluence with an appreciation for good living.

The fact that Fox Lea events draw from all over the country and throughout the year, especially in our 'off season' is also very important. The effects of a spring training team or rowing event in March are hardly felt by the hotels and restaurants in our area due to the large number of seasonal residents already here. However, a hunter jumper show at Fox Lea in July makes a large and noticeable difference in our business. I'm sure area hoteliers would agree.

It is also important to note that previously mentioned activities like spring training baseball and rowing are subsidized by the taxpayers at facilities built and maintained at taxpayers' expense. Fox Lea is privately owned, developed and maintained and pays property taxes on its facilities in addition to generating sales and bed tax revenue. All in all Fox Lea is a great asset to the area and under appreciated.
